Ans: Holy Quran :-

Quran is a (Arabic: "Recitation") also spelled Quran and Koran, The Sacred Scripture of Islam. According to conventional Islamic belief, the Quran was revealed by the angel Gabriel to the prophet Muhammad in the west Arabian towns Mecca and Medina beginning in 610 and ending with Muhammad's death in 632 CE.

First Revelation :-

\* Cave Hira is in Jabal-e-Nour (Nour Mountain) on the road to Mina about 3 miles to the east of Holy Mecca.

\* The prophet was about 40 years old when angel Jibril

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brought the first revelation from Allah.

\* The first revealed verses of the Qur'an are the first 5 verses (Ayats) of Surah Al Alaq.

First revealed verses of Qur'an:-

1:- Read in the name of thy Sustainer,  
who has

2:- Created man out of a  
germ cell

3:- Read - for thy Sustainer, is the  
most Bountiful one

4:- who has taught [man] the  
use of the pen-

5:- taught man what he did  
not know!

The Theme of Qur'an:-

of holy Qur'an consists broadly  
the theme

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of these fundamental beliefs.  
they are:

1. Tauhid - Allah and Predestination
2. Risalah - Angels of Allah, Books of Allah and messengers of Allah.
3. Akhirah - Life after Death and the day of Judgement

Language of Quran:

- ★ The language of Quran is pure and clear arabic.
- ★ The Quran is divided into 30 parts (Parahs in Urdu or Juz in arabic).
- ★ These are 114 chapters (Surahs) in the Quran.
- ★ There are 540 paragraphs (Rukhs) in the Quran.

3rd Ayat:

So they should worship the Lord of this house.

4th Ayat:

He who has fed them against hunger, and made them secure from fear.

Explanation:

Verse one explanation:

"Have you not considered how you handled the companions of the elephant" "fear of the constant security of the Quraysh" And we made them like eaten straw....

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for the constant security of  
the Quraysh.  
Then let them worship the lord  
of his house, "Because their constant  
security let them worship of  
lord of his house.  
"Let them worship him, recognizing  
his favour, acknowledging  
his blessing upon them."  
Then let the worship  
the lord of this house."  
His incredible that these people  
are so secure in their affair?  
yet, they fail to worship  
and continuous to sink  
into falsehood of idol  
worship.

Verse 2 explanation:-

The security  
of Quraysh is mentioned twice:  
and first in a general way,  
and second in regards to  
the caravans that travel  
should in the winter and  
north in the summer.  
There is no conjunction here

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because both are considered blessing!  
 but the letter is single out  
 as a great source of  
 blessing they for live in a  
 barren land.

Verse 3 explanation:-

Lord implies with no partner.  
 Ibn 'Ashur notes that they  
 would only worship Allah  
 on Hajj. Even they would  
 say "we are at your  
 service you have no partner  
 except for those who share  
 in your power." May Allah  
 protect and protect us from that  
 and ground us in tawhid  
 (monotheism)!

Verse 4 explanation:-

The word  
 who implies that Allah is  
 the only true source  
 of provisions.  
 The usage of word "Fear"  
 instead of "hunger" and  
 word "Security" instead of "Fear"

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Points a picture of where the Quraish resided - it is not a hospitable place, nor is it as a place of easing ones basic provisions thus it is a great blessing that in such a situation Allah is taking care of them, providing for them and protecting from harm!

Q. According to Quran what is tauheed effect on human life:

As: Tauheed:-

The difference b/w Islam (Submission to the creating of every thing that exists) and of all other religions which are formulated upon polytheism, this admonition was published is an Islamic news letter, geared towards the muslim leader. However its focus on the meaning of tauheed is enlightening.

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Effect of touheed on human life:-

1:- A believer in this kalimah can never be narrow in outlook. He believes in a God who is the creator of heavens and the earth, the master of the east and west and sustainer of the entire universe. After this belief he does not regard any thing in the world as a stranger to himself.

2:- This belief produces in man the highest degree of self respect and self esteem. The believer knows that Allah alone is the possessor of all power and that not besides him can benefit or harm a person, or provide for his needs or give take away life or wield

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authority or influence.

3:- Along with self respect this belief also generates in man a sense of modesty and humbleness. It makes him unostentatious and unpretending.

4:- This belief makes man virtuous and upright.

5:- The believer never becomes despondent. He has a firm faith in God who is master of all the treasures of the earth and the heavens, who gives grace and bounty without limit and whose power are infinite.

6:- The most important effect of La ilaha illallah is that it makes man obey and observe God's law.
