The first revelation that the Prophet (P.B.U.H) received in the cave of Hira was narrated as follows:

They were the custodians of the Kaaba, and their primary profession was trading, but the most

significant gift was Kaaba.

The term *ikaf* is an infinitive which means 'uniting together' and the term *Ulfat* means 'a gathering with

intimacy & union'. So, the

purpose of using is for the familiarity and union amongst

the Quraish tribe who, together settled there because of the honor, importance & security of the Holy Ka'ba.
