Ans (1) **Sir Syed Ahmed Khan Educational Service.**

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was the first muslim leader who realised the importance of education for his people. In the order of equid the muslim with the ornament of knowledge he opened the following educational institution and societies which revolutioned the life of the muslim of Community.

(1) Two Madrossats in Muradabad (1858) and Ghaziabad (1862) were opened which imparted education in Persian.

- (2) In 1864, Sir Syed Ahmed laid the foundation of Scientific Society which translated English works into Urdu.
- (3) M.A.D High School Aligarh was founded in (1875)
- (4) In 1877, M.A.D High School was given the status of a college and inaugurated on by, viceroy Lord Lytton. Later on, this college became a University in 1920 A.D.

### Political:-

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was eminent political figure and a great visionary. He was renowned muslim reformer of the 19th Century. He had a dream to make the community and country advanced and take them forward on modern shapes. His main

interest was intellectual development of the people through modern education.

In the same year, Sir Syed Ahmed Khan founded the Muhammadan Association to promote political co-operation amongst Indian Muslims from different parts of the country. In 1886 he organised the all India Muhammadan Educational Conference in Aligarh, which promoted his vision of modern education and political unity for Muslims.

Ans No (02) **First political and constitutional phase from 1947 to 1958.**

→ After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of prime minister.

Based at the prime minister Secretariate, the Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaqat Ali Khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 August 1947.

Before the presidential system in 1968, "7" prime ministers had served between 1947 until Marshal law in 1958 by Ayub Khan 1971.
