Discuss Sir Syed Ahmed Khan's educational and political services for the Muslims?

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan's Educational Services:-

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was the first muslim leader who realised the importance of Education for his people. In the Order of Equip the Muslim with the Ornament of Knowledge he opened the following Educational Institutions and Societies with revolutionized the life of the muslim of Community.

* Two maddrasah's in Muradabad (1858) and Ghaziabad (1862) were open which imparted Education in persian.

* In 1864 Sir Syed Ahmed Khan laid the foundation of Scientific Society which translated English works into Urdu.

M.A.D High School Aligarh was founded in (1875).

In 1877, M.A.D High School was given the status of a College and inaugurated by, viceroy Lord Lytton. Later on, this College became a University in 1920 A.D.

Political Services of

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan.

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was eminent political figure and a great visionary. He was renowned Muslim reformer of the 19th Century. He had a dream to make the Community and Country advanced and takes them forward on modern shapes. His main interest was Intellectual development of the people through modern Education. Sir Syed also increased the political awareness of Muslims in the Sub-Continent. At first he believed in Hindu-Muslim Unity but later resolved two Nation-theory. In 1885 the Indian National Congress was set up. It claimed

to be the body of every Indian
regardless of religion.

1958.

Political Phase:-

After the partition of India on the
mid night of 14 and 15 August
1947 Pakistan followed the
British system by creating the
post of Prime Minister.

Based on
the Prime Minister's Secretariat
the Governor General of Pakistan
Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaquat
Ali Khan to establish and
lead his administration at 15 August
1947. Before the presidential system
in 1960, "7" Prime Ministers had
served between 1947 until Martial
Law in 1958 by Ayub Khan.
