#### Background

United States and Pakistan :

To begin with, Pakistan and US had a strong diplomatic relations since the existence of the country. Let us not forget that besides both countries have been allies yet mistrust and fear plagued their relationship. Lets me explain how the story of mistrust started;

Pakistan and Us has been allies against fight what they called **terrorism** for almost twenty years. But, relations have steadily deteriorated since the trump administration began taking a hard line on violent groups in Afghanistan. The white house said it would spend more than two hundred million dollars to end the terrorism.

Most recently in a tweet the US president accused Pakistan of deception and providing a heaven for terrorists, something that the US ambassador to the UN has since reiterated. The US has given Pakistani thirty-three billion dollars over the past sixteen years. More than fourteenth billion dollars of that has been to provide logistical and operational support to US Military operations in Afghanistan.

Pakistan respond to trump by saying he was trying to blame it for America's failure to win the war there. Pakistan has paid a price in it's military involvement with the US. According to the government 50,000 civilians lost their lives since 2003 by US drone attacks as well as attacks by the militants and 6000 members of the security forces have been killed in security operations. Since 2001. Pakistan says the government has lost 123 billion dollars in revenue.

Pakistan insists it wants to focus on peace and reconciliation in it's relationship with the US.

But, with the two countries polarizer over security there is a lot of damage to overcome.

#### Answer :

#### GLOBALIZATION

Globalization is a widely discussed topic it is therefore, not that easy to explain such a complicated term in simple words.

Let me start from the beginning with the background to globalisation.

#### **Background :**

Advancements and technology such as mobile phones, airplanes, telephones and the Internet have made the growth of transport and communication networks possible. Amongst other things this means that people and countries can exchange information and goods more quickly and in a less complicated way. This process is called globalization.

#### History :

Globalization and it's history is the subject of ongoing debate. Several scholars believe that the origins of globalization in the modern era is phenomenon with a long history. Some says it was made for useless purposes in politics. Most people believe that globalization is the results of work of Frank an economist related to dependency theory. However globalization was found by Theodore Levitt.

#### Definition

The word globalization comes from *globe* and means the world wide coming together of countries and nations.

#### **Explanation :**

Companies used to manufacture products in their home counties just like the companies Samsung and apple which produces phones in country. Apple and Samsung sells products in country "a" Their products are in competition with each other. Both the companies pay the same salaries and production Coasts. They have the same customers, use similar suppliers and sell phones at similar prices.

In short the same conditions are applied to both of the companies so far so good. Due to cultural, technical and economical developments that have come about through globalization of companies which manufacturer products on the different conditions can now offer their products in country "a" too. That's why a company from country "b" can also sell phones there at a lower price because they were produced for a lower price. The local phones have to react to stand the competition and so the world grows closer together.

There is an active exchange of goods between the countries. More affordable products are available for more people. However, not only it does exchange of products and economical goods takes places

but services, knowledge, culture goods and even languages. All of these individual elements are closely linked and influence each other. But, "where there is light there is also shadow." because of globalization and this intense exchange of goods people and the environment suffer.

If a company decides to move production to exotically disadvantaged country people and industrialized countries lose their jobs. Similarly, at the same time job opportunities open to many locals in the economically disadvantaged country.

Many people in these countries work for very little money in comparison to those industrialised countries. Therefore, they often remain poor and more often they do not have sufficient insurance, social insurance or health insurance cover.


A further disadvantage of globalization is ecological problems such as climate change.

The use of airplanes, ships and lorries to transport goods over international borders is constantly on the increase. This causes mire CO2 to be released into the atmosphere which in tern is the main cause of global warming.

Even national environmental standards are ignored. This is a further coast factor in the world wide international site competition which should be kept as low as possible to be attractive for a company.

There are therefore many sides to globalisation which effect almost all aspects of life. It causes things that the chain of negative things will grow further.

What important is to realize that globalization it's self is neither good nor bad. Or may be bad but depending upon how people view this personally.

In today's words richest 1% have so much more than everybody else. The vast majority of people have nothing. Two hundred years ago rich countries were only three times richer than poor countries by the end of colonialism in the 1960s they were 35 times richer today they are about 80x richer. Rich countries try to compensate for this by giving aid to poor countries about 130 billion dollars each year. But, the question arises why does the world gap keep getting bigger?

One reason I found is that large corporations are taking more than 900 billion dollars out of poor countries each year. On top of this, each year poor countries are paying 600 billion dollars in debt service to rich countries and loans that have already paid off so times over. And then there is the

money that poor countries lose from trade rules by rich countries to get access to the more resources and cheaper labour. This cost poor countries to lose 500 billion dollars per year. All together that is more than 2 trillion dollars per year that flows from some of the poorest parts of the world to the richest countries every year.

# *Rich governments like to say that they are helping poor countries develop but who is developing who here?*

This makes me think that there is something wrong with the global economy. It cannot be okay that the wealth of the planet is becoming so concentrate in the hands of such a tiny number of people. For now the only hope is to change these rules and systems to stop this destruction from occurring.




#### Solution :
