

Verse-75 Regard for Patience

أُولَئِكَ يُجْزَوْنَ الْغُرْفَةَ بِمَا صَبَرُوا وَيُلَقَّوْنَ فِيهَا تَحِيَّةً وَسَلَامًا

"Those will be rewarded with the highest place (in Paradise) because of their patience. Therein they shall be met with greetings and the word of peace and respect."

Explanation: The first thing that Allah tells us about them in this ayah is that they will be compensated. They will be rewarded for what they have done. This part of the ayah is very important and we should take some time to think about it and reflect on it.

Highest Place in Paradise

أُولَئِكَ يُجْزَوْنَ الْغُرْفَةَ بِمَا صَبَرُوا

"Those will be rewarded with the highest place (in Paradise) because of their patience."

Allah is telling us that they will be compensated and they will be rewarded, this means that Allah is Aware of their situation in this world. Allah is seeing all that they do and all that was done to them. We must keep in mind that Allah is not simply saying that there will be reward, rather He identifies the people for whom there will be reward. He identifies these people who are His's true servants. So it is not enough for someone to simply do good deeds and hope that they will be rewarded because of that, rather to qualify for the reward they must first fulfill the conditions to get that reward. To receive the reward they must be among the true servants of Allah. He has described them in this ayah.
