Lecture No 1: Space Planning in Interior Design

Learning Objectives and Methods of the assignment:

As an introduction to space planning, to the interior design students.

Space planning is a fundamental element of the interior design process.

It starts with an in-depth analysis of how the space is to be used. The designer then draws up a plan that defines the zones of the space and the activities that will take place in those zones.

The space plan will also define the circulation patterns that show how people will move through the space. The plan is finished by adding details of all the furniture, equipment and hardware placement

Space planning is an inherently complex process. For this reason, a series of planning exercises, starting with very small spaces and building to larger spaces with more complex program requirements, are provided as the primary technique in the development of space planning skills.
