Lecture No 5: Understanding and Using Architectural Scales

Introduction of the Lecture:

- 1) To teach students that, as a designer or architect, the industry expectation is that all blueprints, drawings and designs have architectural lettering.
- To teach students professional written presentation skills.
- 3) To teach students how to develop their own architectural lettering style for all writing on drafting projects, including room labels and title block.
- 4) For students to develop good handwriting skills to match the quality of their design, thus avoiding poor handwriting skills that tend to make design plans look amateur.
- 5) To be able to write so that drafted projects are legible, avoiding costly mistakes as a professional in the design industry.
