

➤ A short video or an audio message is a great way to provide some variety to your audience.

➤ Don't rely on embedded media too heavily, it can become

distracting.





DESIGN GUIDELINES - SPECIAL EFFECTS

- Special effects, transitions and animations can add extra interest to your presentation.
- Too many transitions or animations will distract from your main message.
