

Present Tense

- There are four present tense forms:
- Present simple: I work
- Present continuous: I am working
- Present perfect: I have worked
- Present perfect continuous: I have been working

Positive Sentences

- **1.** She goes to college daily.
- 2. He likes music.
- 3. He sleeps at 10 pm.
- 4. They play football in the playground

Negative Sentences

1. I do not eat vegetables.

2. He does not like swimming

Question Sentences

- 1. Do you need some help?
- 2. Does she like music?
- 3. Do they come in time?

Present Progressive Examples

•	am taking	my final exam tomorrow.
• He / She / It	is sweeping	the floor at the moment.
• You / We / They	are giving	me a headache.

• I am not working on that project now

• He / She / It isn't sleeping at the moment

• You / We / They aren't running in the marathon tomorrow

• Am I making myself clear

• Is he / she / it shaking right now

• Are you / we / they buying steaks for dinner tomorrow

• Who am I meeting with today

• What is he / she / it doing right now

• When are you / we / they choosing the colors for the room



Present Perfect Tense

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I have listened.	I haven't listened.	Have listened ?
You have listened.	You haven't listened.	Have you listened ?
He/she/it <u>has</u> listened.	He/she <u>/it</u> <u>hasn't</u> listened.	Has he/she/it listened ?
We have listened. We 'VC	We haven't listened.	Have we listened ?
They have listened.	They haven't listened.	Have they listened ?

Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I have been living here.	I have not I haven't been living here.	Hd_ Have I been living here?
You have been living here.	You haven't been living here. has not	Have you been living here?

Past Simple Tense

- Affirmative Sentences
 - I / He walk<mark>ed</mark> in the park
 - I / He went to the park
- Negative Sentences
 - I / He didn't walk in the park
 - I / He didn't go to the park
- Interrogative Sentences
 - Did you / he walk in the park?
 - Did you / he go to the park?
- Short answers
 - Yes, I / he did (walk / go).
 - No, I / he didn't (walk / go)

<u>I was playing.</u>	I was not playing.	Was I playing?			
You were playing.	You were not playing.	Were you playing?			
He/She/It was playing.	He/She/It wasn't playing.	Was he/she/it playing?			
We were playing.	We weren't playing.	Were we playing?			
They were playing.	They weren't playing.	Were they playing?

Past Perfect Tense

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
I had decided. 1	I hadn't decided.	Had I decided?
You had decided.	You hadn't decided.	Had you decided?
He/ She/lt had decided.	He/She/lt hadn't decided.	Had he/she/it decided ?
We had decided.	We hadn't decided.	Had we decided?
They had decided.	They hadn't decided.	Had they decided?

We had been buying.	We hadn't been buying.	Had we been buying?

Affirmative	Negative	Interrogative
will/shall see.	<u>I will/shall not see.</u>	Will/Shall I see?
You will see.	You won't see.	Will you see?
He/She/It will see.	He/She/It won't see.	Will he/she/it see?
We will/shall see.	We will/shall not see.	Will/Shall we see?
They will see.	They won't see.	Will they see?

They will have arrived.	They won't have arrived.	Will they have arrived?
