Pediatric dentistry

- This is the branch of dentistry dealing with children from birth through adolescence.
- It is an additional program of two to three years after dental graduation degree.
- It includes hospital training, where they work with children who have more severe dental needs and emergencies, and training in numerous orthodontic teeth-straightening methods.



Pediatric dentists

- Pediatric dentists are dentists who are responsible for oral dental health care of children from infancy to teen years.
- They have the experience and qualifications to treat for a child's gums teeth and mouth throughout various stages of childhood.



Need of a pediatric dentist

- Children usually get their milk teeth by first 6 months of life.
- By age 6 or 8 years they start to lose milk teeth and replaced by permanent teeth.
- Proper dental care is required during this period. If not, an oral decay or a tooth disease that can cause a lifetime of pain and complications to teeth.
- Presently early childhood dental caries, an infectious disease is five times common in children than asthma and seven times more common than hay fever.

Type of treatments pediatric dentists offer

- Infant oral health exams plus risk assessment for caries in mother and child.
- Preventive dental care
- Habit counseling
- Habit breaking appliances
- Early assessment and treatment for straightening teeth and correcting an improper bite (orthodontics).
- Repair tooth cavities or defects
- Management of gum disease and pediatric periodontal disease.
- Care for dental injuries.
- Treatments under general anesthesia

Conclusion

- Children require much care during dental examination and treatment. A pediatric dentist knows how to handle the situation and make them comfortable.
- They use specially designed equipments that are designed keeping children in mind.
